








#### SECTIONAL VIEW OF SOUTH FACING MOUNTING SYSTEM




Figure 3: Sectional view of the south facing mounting system



# **EXAMPLE OF FRAME MOUNTED INVERTERS**



Inverters mounted to the frame underneath the panels, rather than housed in a separate container. Up to 5 inverters will be mounted on every other row (so 5 of the 10 rows) on the far west end of each row closest to the cable route back to the point of connection.




Figure 6: View from the north, over the application site towards the reservoir
