I appreciate you have been to the premises and potentially spoken to Mr Buchanan however, as a neighbour to the club we feel a 24hr licence would create the following:

1. More rubbish / litter
2. Anti social behaviour
3. The area is predominantly of a certain age and wouldn't appreciate the additional noise
4. Why does the neighbourhood require a 24hr bar? This is a chalet park bar not a Wetherspoons
5. We don't want to be living in fear of our property being vandalised due to someone sitting in a bar all day & being drunk. No one is going to police this
6. Being a drain on police resources

We also appreciate the Club House is only trying to make a living however, this would be to the detriment to the local area and the neighbours.

We visit the chalet park and know the Buchanan family well, so this isn't a personal attack. We're just very concerned this will cause significant issues, especially when the holiday season starts.
