Reference: Premises Licence Number LN/000014725

I wish to register my objection to the application by David Buchanan for 24 hour licencing at Broadside Clubhouse, Broadside Chalet Park, Stalham, Norfolk, NR12 9PN, on the following grounds:

- The chalet park is located in a residential area of Stalham and the sale of alcohol
 during breakfast opening at the clubhouse will change the nature of its clientele.
 Extending the licencing to 24 hours will change it into a venue for late night
 drinking. This is not in keeping with the family values and ethos of the area.
- Noise levels from drinkers arriving and leaving will unavoidably increase and occur into the early hours of the morning. There will be an inevitable increase in disturbance to sleep for both children and adults.
- In the area of the clubhouse noise levels will increase at all times of night, in particular in the summer when the doors and windows of the clubhouse are open.

4. Parking is already a problem during busy periods and more so now that waste bins have been sited in each car park which has reduced parking space further. Inviting non-residents on to the site will increase pressures on parking and cause obstruction of the access roads and verges around the park.

I hope you will not approve this application and I am sure that the majority of chalet park owners agree that it would be an undesirable change.
