Q.6	<i>There is a real problem with speeding and what might be called "inappropriate driving" in our villages. Given pressures on finance and police resources, what measures are being entertained by the Police and Crime Commissioner to remedy this problem?</i>	
Q.7	<i>What strategies are being employed to reduce drink and drug driving and how effective are they?</i>	
Q.8	<i>Will numbers of beat policemen in North Norfolk be increased to improve coverage?</i>	
Q.9	<i>What is the role of the police in reducing domestic violence?</i>	

Q.10	<i>Is the PCC happy with the numbers of Beat Officers deployed to the Districts? N.B. The following is not to be quoted in public or put in any report that is publicised but I'm told that at any one time there are 7 – 8 beat officers deployed in North Norfolk, an area stretching from Holkham to Hickling. Seems low to me.</i>	
Q.11	<i>Is the PCC happy with the effort the police put into reducing speeding? This is a particular issue in Fakenham.</i>	
Q.12	<i>What resources and numbers of Norfolk police are deployed to preventing and investigating online crime?</i>
